Easy Art Instructions use provided paper and follow these simple steps to create great art for lasting keepsakes!

Artwork can be VERTICAL or HORIZONTAL. All artwork is reproduced "AS IS" using the full sheet of paper.

KEEP DESIGN SIMPLE. FILL THE SPACE.

- Extend background colors to the edge of all four sides.
- Erase all pencil lines or unwanted marks that you do not want to see on your final products.

Tip: Artwork should be easily seen from across the room.

USE BOLD COLORS.

These mediums have been found to work very well:

- Markers ◆Crayons ◆Tempera Paint ◆Oil Crayons
- •Intense Water Colors •Paper Collage

Tip: For skin or flesh tones, color heavily to fill in as much as possible.

NAMES, DATES & WORDS.

- Must be at least 1" from the edge of the paper.
- Incorporate this information into the picture.
- Make lettering as large as possible, as it will be reduced on many of our products.

DESIGNS, BORDERS ON THE EDGES.

- If you are using a border, make it colorful.
- Borders should be at least 1" thick.
- Do not place important parts of your image in borders.

Tip: During processing some slight cropping may occur. If creating a paper collage, please trim any excess paper from the edge of the artwork.

PLEASE LABEL ALL ARTWORK ON BACK.

- Include the student's name, school, teacher and grade on the back of the artwork.
- Place a "T" on the back to indicate top.
